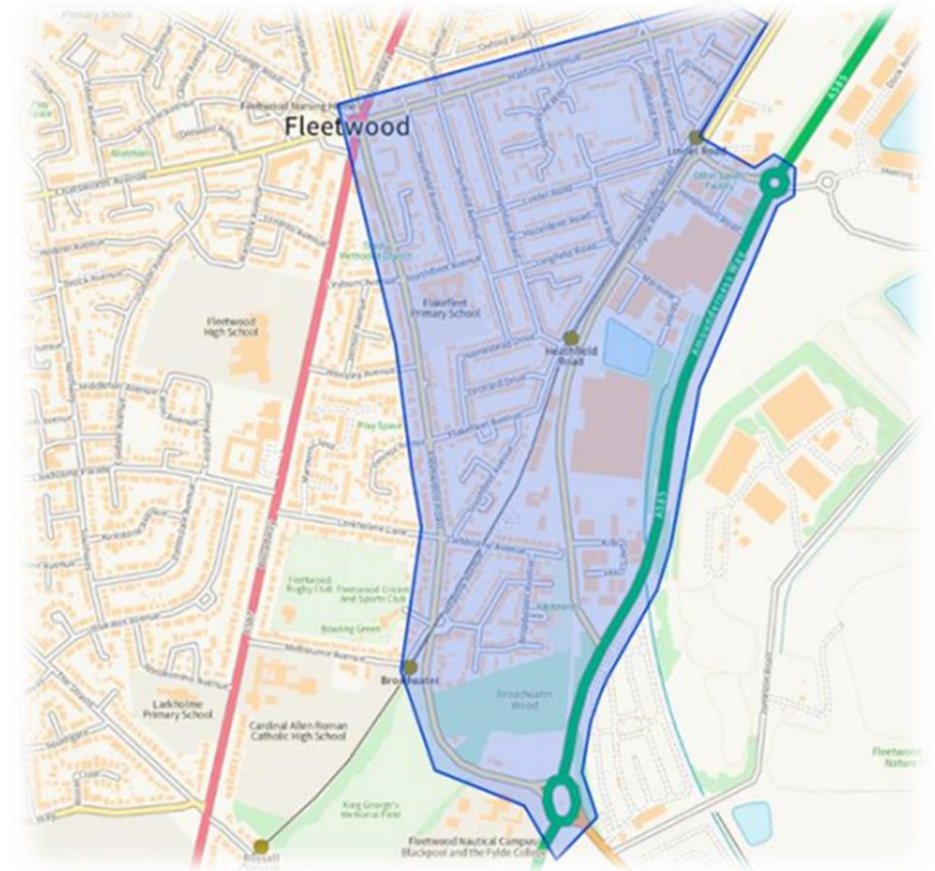

Analysis

- High Crime – **10% of Wyre Crime in Park / Mount wards**
- 4 OCG Groups within 1 KM2
- Low levels of community intelligence – Low Confidence
- Index of Multiple Deprivation – Fleetwood wards in top 10% most deprived in UK
- MORILE score – **371**

Analysis



- Lancashire Talking Data *Drugs and ASB top issues in Fleetwood. 52% had confidence in Police dealing with crime, 47% had confidence in Police dealing with ASB*
- Violent crime linked to organised crime and **negatively impacted community confidence**
- Environmental Survey – Broken window theory – DOCO Report – **Fly tipping / graffiti / CCTV** as well as verbal feedback from community

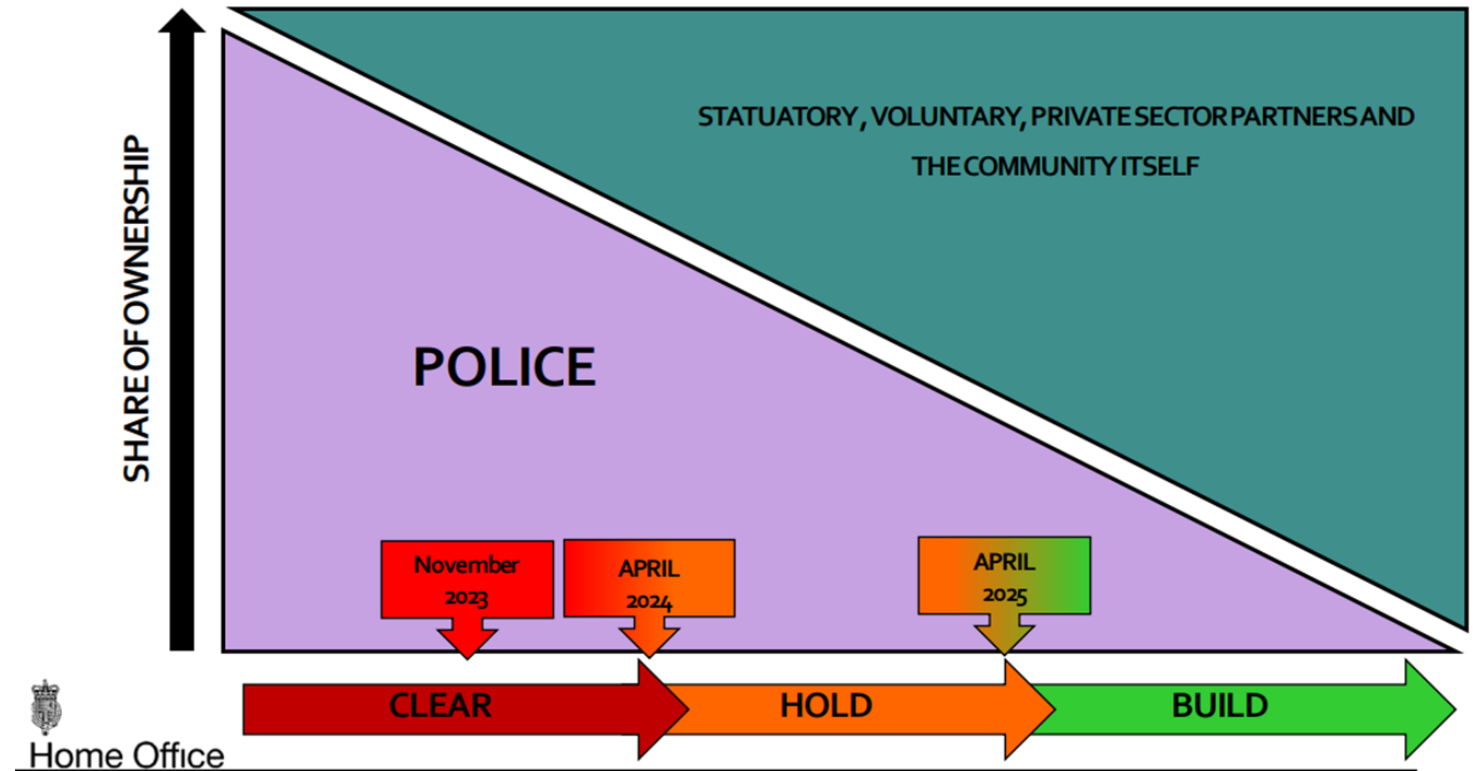

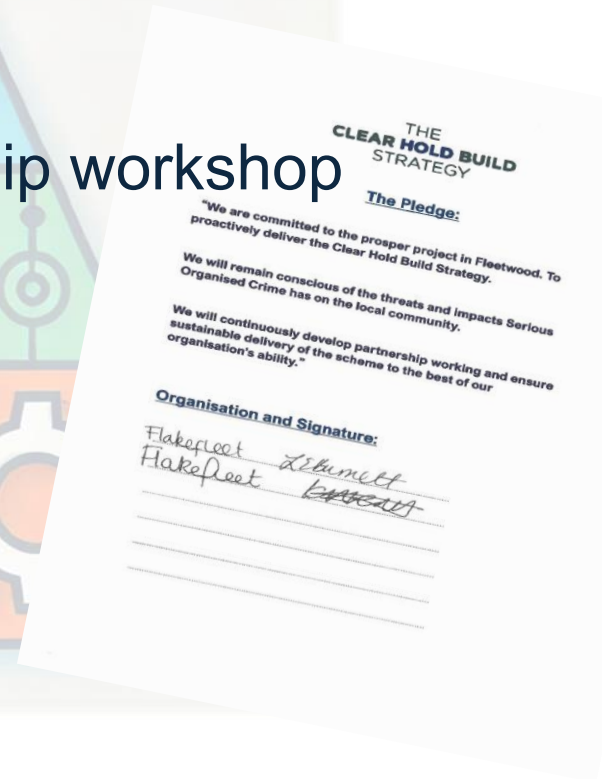

Response - Enforcement



- 125 - Section 23 Misuse of Drugs Act Warrants
- 549 arrests made by Task Force team dedicated to CHB – 101 for drug supply
- 102 years prison sentencing
- £372k Cash seized
- £4.5 Million Drugs seized

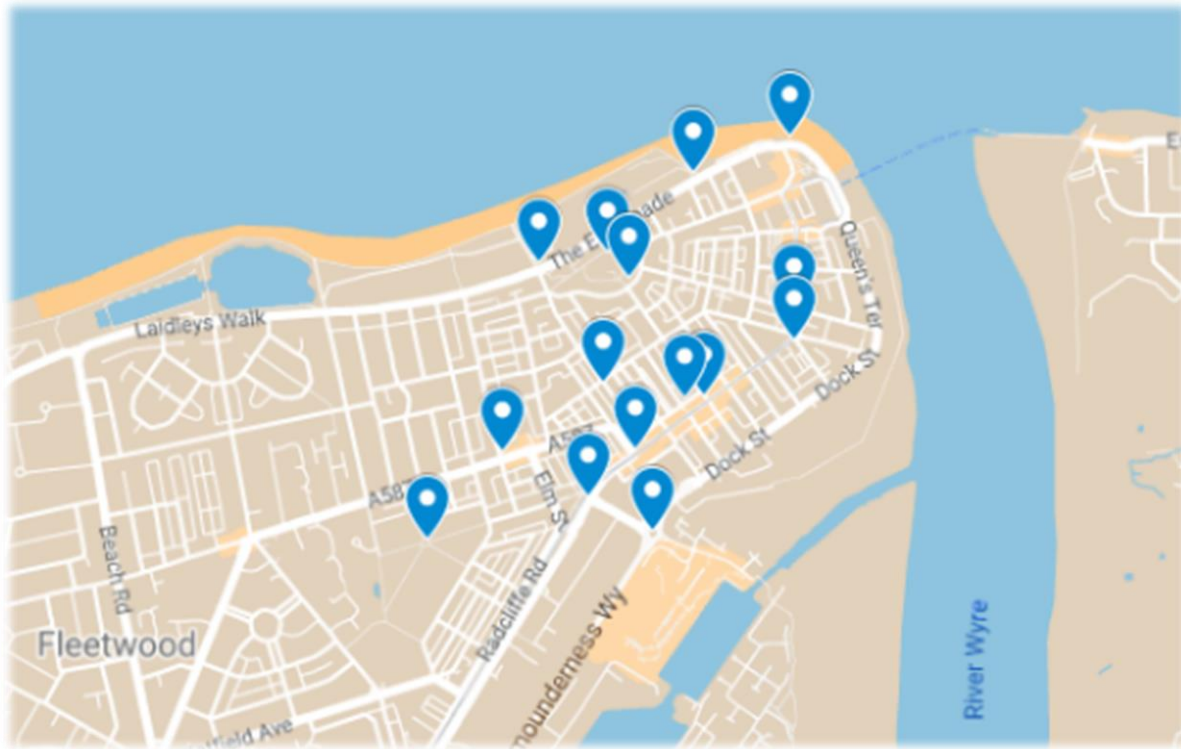

Confidence data Lancashire Talking

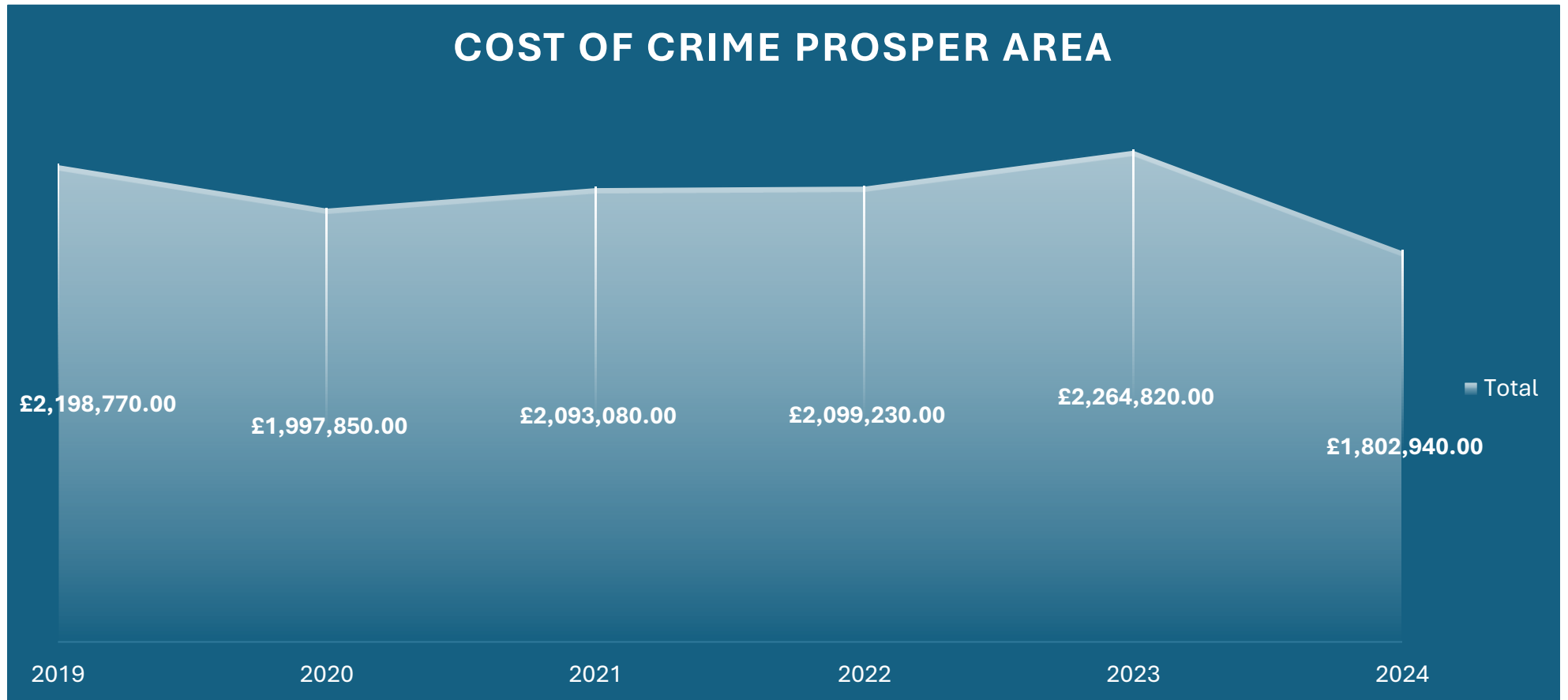
- Police are dealing with CRIME = 70% up 18% / ASB 71% = up 24%
- The Police are doing a good job 75% up 16% Confidence = 78% up 18%

Crime / ASB – Down due to increased intelligence (up 74%)

- Crime down 12% overall compared to 4% in Wyre, ASB down 24% compared to 10%

Cost of crime down by £296,290 from 2022
